

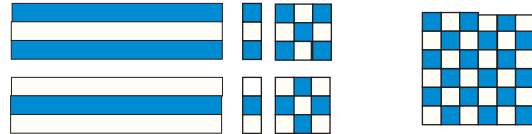
Strip Quilting with Kaye Wood

Strip Cut Stars the easy Starmaker® Master Template Way ©Kaye Wood

Sew these two combination strips together—each with 3 strips

Cut squares.

Cut into strips of squares
Sew 3 pieces into a 9-patch
Combine several into a quilt block



Cut stars from the same strips.

Place the bottom of a Starmaker® Master Template along the bottom of the strip.
Cut along the angle of the Starmaker.

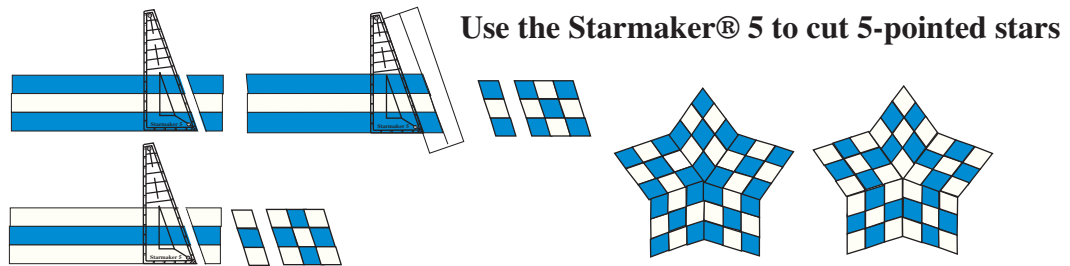
Use a ruler to measure the size and the Starmaker to cut the angle of each piece.

If each strip was cut 2" wide, place a 2" line on the ruler along the angled cut.

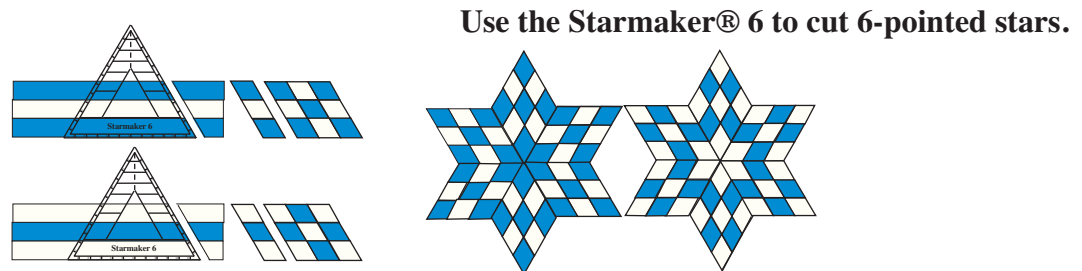
Butt the Starmaker next to the ruler; remove the ruler and cut the pieces.

Sew 3 pieces (alternate the colors) together to make one point of a star.

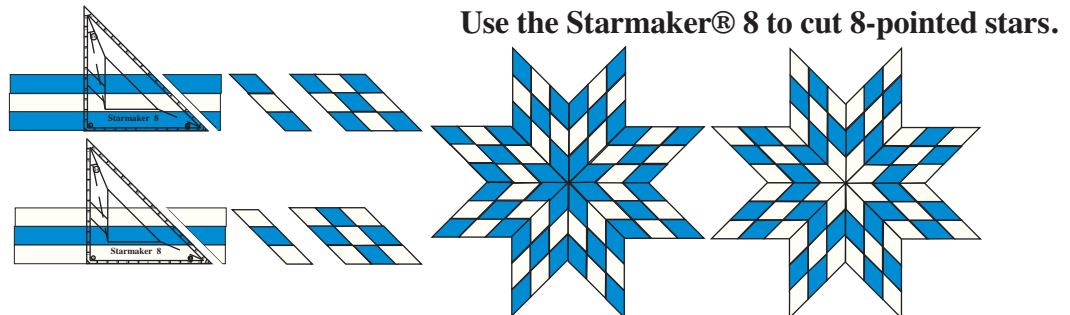
Two different stars can be made using each Master Template.



Use the Starmaker® 5 to cut 5-pointed stars



Use the Starmaker® 6 to cut 6-pointed stars.



Use the Starmaker® 8 to cut 8-pointed stars.
