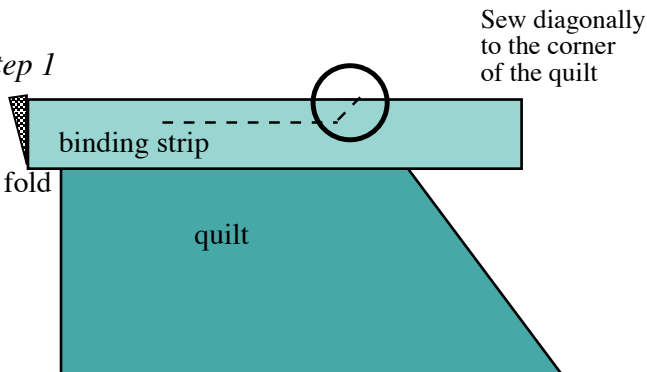

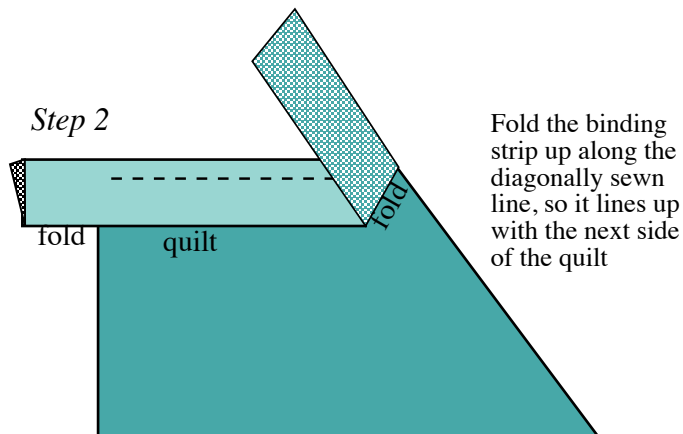
Quilt Bindings

PerfectMiter™ for hexagon shapes

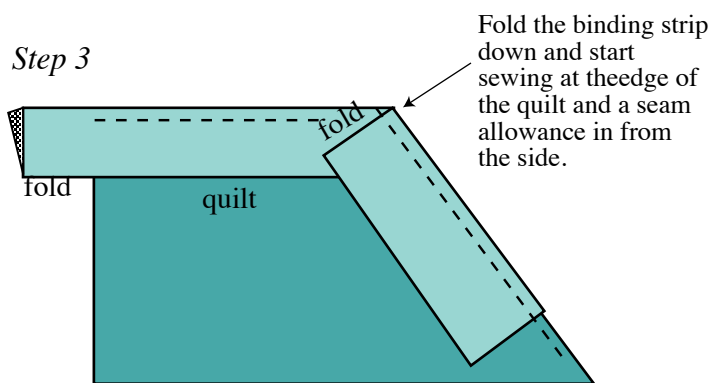
Step 1

A binding finishes off the edges and frames the quilt. A hexagon miter is just as easy as the square miter shown last month.

Binding strips can be cut on the bias or straight of grain.

A double binding is the most durable. Double binding strips are cut 6 times the finished width (the part that shows on the front of the quilt) of the binding.

Fold the binding in half, wrong sides together.

Sew the binding to the quilt using my PerfectMiter™ technique to miter the corners, following the directions at left.

Bring the folded edge of the binding to the back of the quilt and hand stitch it in place.
